European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2023

Emergency Competent Authority Exemption 08/2024

Applicable To National Road Transport Only

Carriage of UN 1017 Chlorine in non-ADR pressure receptacles

The Health and Safety Authority, as Competent Authority appointed under Regulation 10 of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment) Regulations 2011 to 2023, and in accordance with Regulation 5(4)(a), hereby exempts

Brenntag Chemicals Distribution (Ireland) Limited, Unit 405 Grants Road, Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, Dublin, D24 FC80

from the provisions of:

(i) Regulation 55 of the European Communities (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations) 2011 to 2023

AND

(ii) Article 4 of Directive 2008/68/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of the 24 September 2008 on the inland transport of dangerous goods, as amended, which states:

The transport of dangerous goods between Member States and third countries shall be authorised in so far as it complies with the requirements of the ADR, RID or ADN, unless otherwise indicated in the Annexes.

Purpose

The purpose of this exemption is to permit the carriage of UN 1017 Chlorine in non-ADR compliant pressure receptacles (pressure drums GC107/380).

The following transport operations are permitted under this exemption:

A. The carriage of UN 1017 Chlorine in non-ADR compliant pressure receptacles (pressure drums GC107/380) listed in **Table 1-08/2024** below, from Dublin Port to Brenntag Chemicals Distribution (Ireland) Limited, Unit 405 Grants Road, Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, Dublin, D24 FC80 and from Brenntag Chemical Distribution (Ireland) premises in Greenogue Business Park to:

- Veolia Water Ireland Ltd., Clareville Water Treatment Plant, Castleconnell, County Limerick, V94XT93;
- Uisce Éireann, Inniscarra Waterworks, The Waterworks, Inniscarra, County Cork, P31X738;
- Uisce Éireann Nenagh Regional Water Supply Plant, Coolbawn, Nenagh, County Tipperary, E45C438;

until **30 April 2024**.

- B. The return of empty pressure drums from the three water treatment plants (listed above) and a fourth water treatment plant:
- Uisce Éireann, Leixlip Waterworks, The Waterworks, County Kildare, W23PA40; to Brenntag Chemicals Distribution (Ireland) Limited and to Dublin Port until **30 June 2024**.
- C. The return of two empty pressure drums, serial numbers 7729 and 12245 from:
- Uisce Éireann Nenagh Regional Water Supply Plant, Coolbawn, Nenagh, County Tipperary, E45C438; to Brenntag Chemicals Distribution (Ireland) Limited and to Dublin Port until **30 June 2024**.

The transport operations shall also comply with the provisions contained in this document.

1. The emergency services must be notified about this authorisation and be provided in advance with a schedule of transport operations within the State under the provisions of the authorisation.
2. In all other respects, the transport operations performed in accordance with this exemption will comply with the relevant requirements of ADR.
3. A copy of this exemption must accompany the transport documentation and shall be made available to anyone who has a legitimate interest in the transport operation.
4. Any incident resulting in loss of containment of a substance during the transport journey shall be reported immediately by the participant in control of the transport operation to the emergency services and the:

5. The Authority may withdraw this exemption for failure to observe any of these conditions or for any other reason, which the Authority deems sufficient.

This exemption is effective immediately and expires on (i) **30 April 2024** for the carriage of full pressure drums and (ii) **30 June 2024** for the return of empty pressure drums.
